This charter defines RTBL as an international, private, non-governmental digital registry and certification initiative for startup broadcast brands.

1. International Purpose

RTBL is designed to be accessible to broadcasters from multiple countries and regions. RTBL registry status is based on private membership, verification workflow, declarations, and annual renewal.

2. Neutrality

RTBL does not claim authority from any single country or government. It may accept members from many regions, subject to RTBL policies, sanctions, payment availability, risk review, and applicable law.

3. Transparency

RTBL should make clear on certificates, badges, website pages, and terms that it is private and does not replace local official approvals.

4. Safety and Rights

RTBL should maintain complaint, abuse, and rights-review channels to protect the integrity of the registry and reduce misuse.

5. Future Development

RTBL may add APIs, third-party verification partners, country guidance pages, education programs, technical audits, and multi-station network tools.
